**Subject:** Endeavour InvenTeam Trip to MIT

Dear Parents,

Last night (1/13/04) we had a very enthusiastic and productive meeting to plan for our June trip to showcase the InvenTeam invention at MIT. It was attended by 10 students and 15 parents.

We have scheduled our next meeting for Thursday, 1/22/04, 5:30 pm in room 922.

\*\*\*\*\* Minutes, MIT Meeting #1, 1/13/04 \*\*\*\*\*

- About 25 people are planning on traveling from SLO to Boston on June 17 and returning on June 20.
- We need to raise about \$400 per student (15 x \$400 = \$6000).
- Parents will pay their own way.
- Students will be in groups of 3 to 5 with at least one parent chaperone for each group. These groups will travel and lodge together.
- Students will receive credit for hours spent in group fund raising efforts and will be credited with a proportionate share of the proceeds. They will also be credited directly for any deposit of funds they make in lieu of or in addition to fund raising.
- March 15 will be the deadline for each student to have a total credit equal to the travel costs.
- Sales of See's candy bars was suggested but discussion changed to Krispy Kremes first.
- We plan to pre-sell 850 dozen (or more) donuts during the last two weeks of February for pickup on Friday, Feb 27 between 7 & 8 AM at both the high school and the district office.
- Each dozen will cost us \$4 and will be sold at \$8. This means we expect a profit of \$4 x 850 = \$3400.
