Men's volleyball tryouts are today and tomorrow at 3:15 PM. We meet at the weight room.

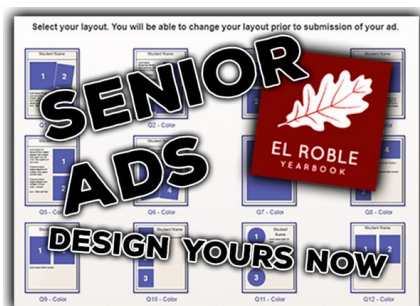
SATURDAY SCHOOL

STREET AND SCHOOL SAFETY!

Students, please be careful and also advise your parents when dropping off or picking up from school not to stop in the middle of the street, open car doors or step into traffic. Do not jaywalk; there are plenty of marked cross walks to cross the streets safely and legally. Also please do not double park in the parking lot, please park in marked stalls only. There is also a marked loading and unloading zones for safe drop off and pick up. Finally if you are under 18 years of age you must wear a helmet when riding a bike, skateboard or scooter. DRESS CODE
