BLIND DATE WITH A BOOK

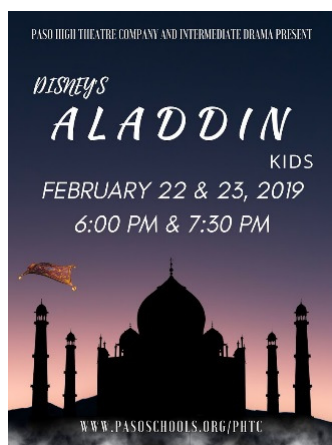
