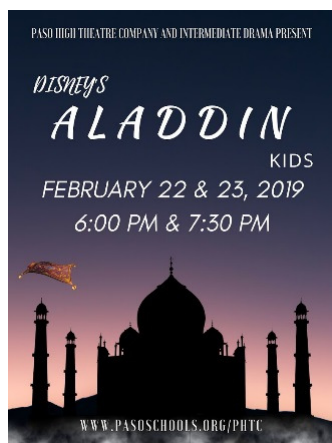

PARKING LOTS
