BLACK HISTORY MONTH ART IN THE LIBRARY

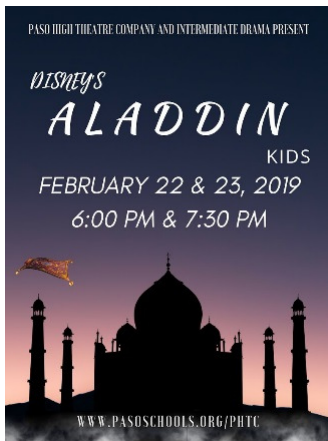
Come to the Library during lunch through February 20th to participate in coloring collaborative posters to celebrate Black History Month. Please see Library Staff for details.
