MOCK ROCK SIGN-UPS

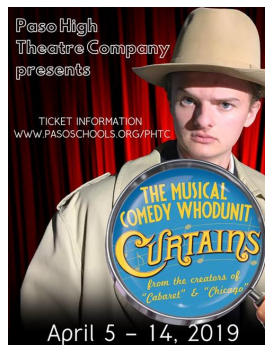
