If you are on the no privilege list starting April 19<sup>th</sup>, you will not be able to purchase a ticket online and must get off the no privilege list before purchasing a ticket.

### **DRESS CODE**

### **PARKING LOTS**

Bearcats, please know the parking lots are off limits throughout the school day including Nutrition Break and Lunch. Make sure your books, snacks, and lunches are in a backpack or on your person; we will not allow students to go to the parking lot at any time during the school day.

### **STREET AND SCHOOL SAFETY!**

Students, please be careful and also advise your parents when dropping off or picking up from school not to stop in the middle of the street, open car doors or step into traffic.
