PARKING LOTS

Make sure your books, snacks, and lunches are in a backpack or on your person; we will not allow students to go to the parking lot at any time during the school day.

STREET AND SCHOOL SAFETY!

Students, please be careful and also advise your parents when dropping off or picking up from school not to stop in the middle of the street, open car doors or step into traffic. There is also a marked loading and unloading zones for safe drop off and pick up. Finally if you are under 18 years of age you must wear a helmet when riding a bike, skateboard or scooter. Law enforcement officers will be enforcing the laws and issuing citations for any violations!
