## **IMPORTANT CHROMEBOOK INFORMATION**

It's that time of year again!

Summer! With summer comes the opportunity for you to keep your Chromebook. This will save you time on orientation day since you will only need to pick up your textbooks. **IF YOU ARE TAKING SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES YOU MUST KEEP YOUR CHROMEBOOK OVER THE SUMMER AND RETURN THE SUMMER USAGE FORM.**

If you want to keep your Chromebook over the summer here is what you need to know – Grab a Summer Usage form from your tutorial teacher or come into the library and get one. Fill it out and have your parents sign it. Return to the library no later than May 24<sup>th</sup>. If you purchased insurance for this school year you won't need to buy any for the summer. If you didn't purchase insurance, and want to for the summer ONLY, it's just \$5. Pick up a Summer Usage form from your tutorial teacher or the library. If you keep your Chromebook over the summer this does not mean you don't have to fill out the goldenrod next school year. Your insurance and Acceptable Use Policy expires on the first day of the 2019-20 school year. To avoid having your device locked, you will need to turn in your forms.

If you're nodding your head "Yes" and are between the ages of 8 and 17, you can take a free Young Eagle flight & see what pilots do on the ground & in the air. Tomorrow, members of EAA Chapter 465 of Paso Robles will provide free flights to introduce young people to aviation at the Paso Robles Airport. Flights will originate from the vicinity of the airport terminal, commencing at approximately 9 to 10 am, weather permitting. A parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a permission form prior to the flight.
