WORK PERMIT REQUIRED

If you have a job and are under 18 years old, you are required to have a work permit on file at school and at work. Go to the front office ASAP for a green Work Permit Application. You need a new permit every school year; current permits expire September 1st.

NOTICE

For the protection and safety of all our students and staff, Paso Robles Joint Unified School District requires all visitors to provide a photo ID before entering school grounds.

DRESS CODE

Law enforcement officers will be enforcing the laws and issuing citations for any violations!
