The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) wants to acknowledge students with good grades. If you are a sophomore, junior, or senior and earned above a 3.3 with no D's or F's last semester you may qualify. Pick up an application from Mr. LeClair in room 1023. Become a Lifetime Member and earn an academic cord for graduation, a gold seal on your diploma, and become eligible for scholarships. Applications for sophomores are free this semester. Applications for juniors and seniors are \$5.00. Applications must be submitted by September 7.

STREET AND SCHOOL SAFETY!

Do not jaywalk; there are plenty of marked cross walks to cross the streets safely and legally. Also please do not double park in the parking lot, please park in marked stalls only. Law enforcement officers will be enforcing the laws and issuing citations for any violations!
