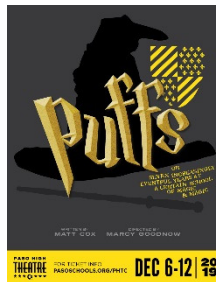
## BEARCATS CARE

**SAFETY!**
