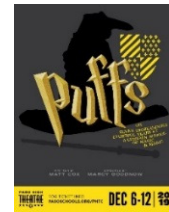
LIFE SAVERS CLUB BLAZE PIZZA FUNDRAISER

Seniors! Saturday, November 30th is deadline for UC/CSU applications -Friday, November 22nd our last day of school before break, which means PRHS's last day to be able to help you before your application is due. PLEASE STOP IN AND HAVE SOMEONE IN THE CAREER CENTER LOOK AT YOUR APPLICATION BEFORE YOU SUBMIT! There are lots of "issues" with the CSU application and we want to make sure we fix them before you submit! We are taking college app drop in help today and tomorrow during lunch and after school. *If you took a dual enrolled course (like Spanish II) or a course at Cuesta (like HIST 207A/B), please make sure you know your MyCuesta log-in information. Without being able to log-in to your account, your college application may not be accurate. We are here to help you! Please stop by if you have any questions or concerns!
