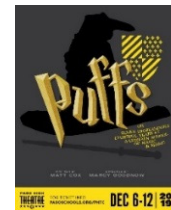
LAST DAY TO GET HELP ON YOUR UC/CSU COLLEGE APPLICATION

Seniors! Saturday, November 30th is deadline for UC/CSU applications. TODAY is our last day of school before break, which means PRHS's last day to be able to help you before your application is due. PLEASE STOP IN AND HAVE SOMEONE IN THE CAREER CENTER LOOK AT YOUR APPLICATION BEFORE YOU SUBMIT! There are lots of "issues" with the CSU application and we want to make sure we fix them before you submit! We are taking college app drop in help today and tomorrow during lunch and after school. *If you took a dual enrolled course (like Spanish II) or a course at Cuesta (like HIST 207A/B), please make sure you know your MyCuesta log-in information. STREET AND SCHOOL SAFETY!

Students, please be careful and also advise your parents when dropping off or picking up from school not to stop in the middle of the street, open car doors or step into traffic. Do not jaywalk; there are plenty of marked cross walks to cross the streets safely and legally. Also please do not double park in the parking lot, please park in marked stalls only.
