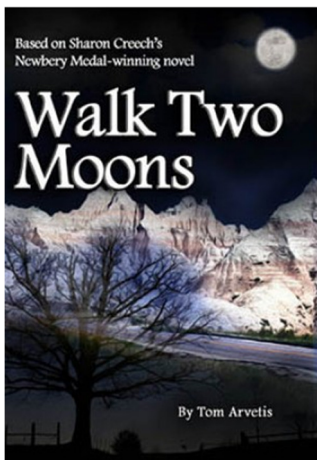

ASVAB CAREER EXPLORATION PROGRAM

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)/Career Exploration Program (CEP) assessment will be administered on Tuesday, December 4th in Bearcat Hall. The testing will start at 8:15 AM. Please check in with your 1st period teacher and proceed to Bearcat Hall at 8:00. The ASVAB determines what jobs you are qualified for in the military and the CEP is a career planning and exploration program that combines a multiple-aptitude test with an interest self-assessment and a wide range of career exploration tools. Several weeks after the assessment, you will be provided a detailed report of possible career fields in which you show an aptitude and interest.

DRESS CODE

Please dress respectfully. Students in violation of the dress code will be offered alternative attire to wear for the day (if possible).
