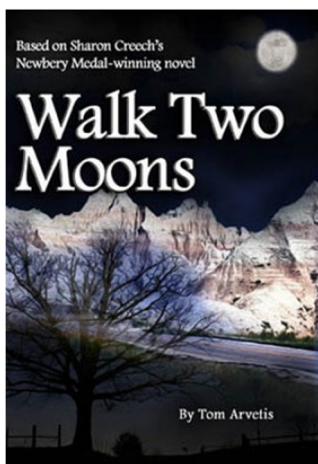

## ASVAB CAREER EXPLORATION PROGRAM

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)/Career Exploration Program (CEP) assessment will be administered tomorrow in Bearcat Hall. The testing will start at 8:15 AM. Please check in with your 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher and proceed to Bearcat Hall at 8:00. The ASVAB determines what jobs you are qualified for in the military and the CEP is a career planning and exploration program that combines a multiple-aptitude test with an interest self-assessment and a wide range of career exploration tools. Several weeks after the assessment, you will be provided a detailed report of possible career fields in which you show an aptitude and interest.
