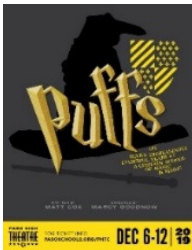

Bearcats! The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)/Career Exploration Program (CEP) assessment will be administered to 10th, 11th, and 12th graders on Monday, December 9th in Bearcat Hall at 8:00 AM. The ASVAB/CEP determines what jobs students are qualified for in the armed services and is also a career planning program that combines a multiple-aptitude test with an interest self-assessment. For students interested in military service after high school, taking this test is a must!
