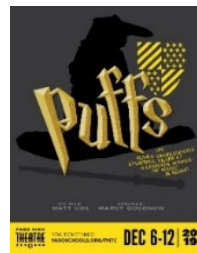
SENIOR GRAD NIGHT

**GATE ALARM ACTIVATION
AND MAIN OFFICE
ENTRY/EXIT POLICY**

Dear Bearcats. Starting Monday, December 16, campus entry and exit during the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM (2:00 PM on Weds.) must be through the Main Office only. Students may not open the alarmed gates by the flagpole and student parking lot at any time. Doing so will trigger the alarm and be cause for severe school discipline: suspension and possible monetary fine if emergency services are dispatched. Our new camera system will enable identification of individuals triggering the alarm to ensure strict enforcement; do not violate this policy and read the signs at the gates as a reminder. The only time exit through the alarmed gates is permissible is during an actual emergency. Students with reduced-day schedules will continue to be allowed to exit through the 500 Gate during lunch time; a staff member will continue to monitor the open gate during lunch-time exit. Additionally, item drop off during the school day is only permissible by adults or adult siblings listed on emergency cards and must be delivered through the Main Office. No curb-side drop offs or handing off of items through the interior fence or gates is allowed. With your help, we will adhere to the new policy to increase campus safety and security for all Bearcats. Thank you for your support.

**STREET AND SCHOOL
