Welcome to the public display of instructional materials. The purpose of the public display is to provide the public the opportunity to give input on the recommended materials, as they will be recommended for adoption to the Paso Robles School District Board of Trustees.

There are two ways to provide input on the recommended materials. One is an informal process using the Questions, Concerns, and Compliments form. The other is the formal process using the Challenge to Recommended Instructional Materials for Board Adoption form. Both will be submitted to the Curriculum Review Committee, and written answers will be provided for both. The informal process allows the public to ask questions and give comments without challenging the adoption. The formal process requires specific time lines to be followed, and its intent is to allow the public to challenge the adoption. Formal challenges will be accepted only from district staff, residents of the district, and/or parents and guardians of students enrolled in a district school.

Sports Medicine Essentials: Core Concepts in Athletic Training & Fitness Instruction (3rd Edition) is a high school- and college-level textbook that encompasses athletic training and fitness curriculum. Written by an athletic trainer certified by the National Athletic Trainers' Association (NATA), this textbook teaches students the skills needed for a career in sports medicine in roles such as athletic trainer, physical therapist, or strength and conditioning specialist. The textbook covers topics such as anatomy and physiology, emergency preparedness, vital signs, treatment and prevention of injuries, and physical rehabilitation, among many other topics.
