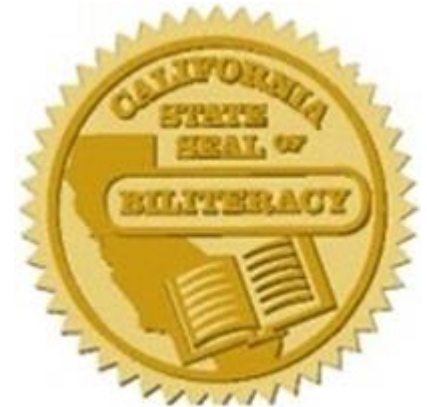

What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by a school, school district, county office of education, or state in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation. Our vision is to help students recognize the value of their academic success and see the tangible benefits of being bilingual. The Seal of Biliteracy takes the form of a gold seal that appears on the transcript or diploma of the graduating senior and is a statement of accomplishment for future employers and for college admissions.

The California State Seal of Biliteracy for PRHS Seniors

This program recognizes high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing one or more languages in addition to English.





Language Proficiency Options

Demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English by ONE of the following:

- Advanced Placement Exam with a score of 3 or higher
- International Baccalaureate Exam with a score of 4 or higher
- SAT II foreign language exam score of 600 or higher
- Successfully complete a four-year high school course of study in a foreign language (i.e. Spanish 4 or above) with a 3.0 or higher GPA, *and oral proficiency in the language comparable to that required to pass an AP or IB examination.*



Requirements

- Complete all high school graduation requirements
- Complete all semesters of English with a 2.0 or higher GPA
- Earn a score of Met Standards or Exceeded Standards on the 11th grade SBAC ELA test.
- Demonstrate proficiency in one or more languages other than English by fulfilling ONE of the options listed at right
- Fill out application on this brochure and turn it in by the deadline.
