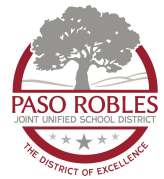




Senior Contract

Graduation Expectations and Responsibilities

Our goal is to have a graduation ceremony that is dignified and memorable for all graduates and their families. By agreeing to the following areas, you will help insure that this will be the type of ceremony that we will all be proud of.

1. Maintain satisfactory citizenship in class, on campus and at all school activities through the remainder of the school year. If you engage in a behavior that leads to a school suspension or site contract may exclude you from participating in the graduation ceremony.
2. Clear all fines, including textbooks, library, athletics, and P.E., prior to graduation practice.
3. Attend and cooperate at all scheduled graduation practices.
4. Wear a cap and gown that has not been altered or decorated in any fashion. You may not wear a lei or any similar decoration. All approved graduation regalia is listed on the PRHS website. Tassels will be worn on the left side of the cap.
5. Wear professional attire under the gown. Please note: The graduates are **NOT** allowed to carry personal items (e.g. purses, makeup kits, cell phones or cameras) onto the field or into the gym.
6. Remember: All school rules are in effect at ALL school activities and functions including the rule pertaining to the use or possession of alcohol or drugs. This includes the graduation ceremony and all practices.
7. Do not bring non-approved items (e.g. cell phones, balloons, beach balls, air horns) to the graduation ceremony. A search of each graduate will be conducted prior to the ceremony. Students bringing non-approved items may be excluded from the ceremony. **Photo ID required for entry into the gym.**
8. Conduct yourself courteously, and participate in the program as planned without distraction or disruption. Failure to do so may result in your removal during the graduation ceremony.
9. Show respect for each and every graduate.
