



Hotspot Student Use Agreement

PRJUSD hotspots are checked out to students who need an internet connection to finish their school work at home and are for the sole use of the student. Students using district-issued hotspots must understand that they are using school equipment and that all current school rules and policies apply. Content on district-issued devices, including the hotspot, is filtered and CIPA (Child Internet Protection Act) compliant.

Hotspot, charger, and case will be issued through the library. Parents and students must sign and return the Insurance Agreement and Enrollment form and also must have a current Acceptable Use Policy on file. All components of the hotspot are expected to be returned in the condition they were issued to you and will be collected at the end of the school year. Summer school students will have the option to extend the use of their hotspot through the summer. There are a limited number of devices and a possible waiting list.

General Precautions:

- No food or drink is allowed next to your hotspot while it is in use.
- Cords must be inserted carefully into the hotspot.
- Students must transport their hotspot in the case with the case closed.
- To conserve battery life, please shut off your hotspot when not in use.
- **Hotspots and cases must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels that are not the property of the Paso Robles Joint Unified School District.**
- PRJUSD and device labels must not be removed.
- Hotspots must never be left in a car or any unsupervised area.
- Do not submerge the device in water nor drop it or expose it to extreme situations.

Device Data Capacity:

- Hotspots have a daily data limit of 500MB which is adequate to complete most school assignments.
- Streaming large amounts of audio or video files will deplete this 500MB quickly.
- When the 500MB limit is reached, the device will go to sleep until the next day.
- Hotspots are for the sole use of the PRJUSD student and it is the student's responsibility to monitor their data usage.

Failure to follow guidelines as set forth in this agreement can result in disciplinary consequences issued by the student's school site administration.

Insurance:

School district protection is available for students and parents to cover hotspot replacement in the event of theft, **accidental damage**, or fire. The protection cost is \$5.00 annually for each device with a maximum cost of \$10.00 per family. Please report all hotspot problems to your school's library technician.

I have received, read, and discussed with my child the terms of this agreement and the policies listed in the Student Hotspot Use Agreement. I understand the terms of the Student Acceptable Use Agreement and the options for insurance coverage of the device.

INSURANCE FOR ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE, THEFT, OR FIRE: Following are the two options that are available for these types of losses, and the student/parent must commit to one by checking the appropriate box.

- No Insurance** I agree to pay for the replacement and repair of the hotspot at a cost of \$100 should the device be stolen or damaged.
- School District Protection** I choose to pay PRJUSD an annual protection payment for coverage of accidental damage or theft to the hotspot in the amount of \$5.00 with a \$10 deductible if damage should occur. (PRJUSD covers the cost of insurance for homeless and foster students.) The \$5.00 yearly payment is non-refundable. This annual coverage begins upon receipt of the payment and ends at the conclusion of each school year. Cash or checks payable to Paso Robles JUSD are accepted.
